MAKE A MOUSE

There's never just one right way to create something, just like a great soup can have different ingredients. Here are some suggestions - feel free use your imagination!

Materials

Small pieces of felt Scissors Needle and thread Stuffing (batting, yarn, scraps) Tail (yarn, string, pipe cleaner) Glue or hot glue (have an adult help you with hot glue)



Directions

- 1. Using the patterns below cut out the shapes one mouse body and two ears.
- 2. Fold the body in half and sew it together with a running stitch starting at the nose (the point) stopping and stuffing the mouse when you have about an inch left (use a pen, a knitting needle, or a chopstick to get the stuffing down to the nose) then finish sewing.
- 3. Cut the slit in the ear (or make a tiny tuck), overlap the two sides and sew or glue the ears, one to each side, about half way down the back of the body,
- 4. Draw on eyes with a marker or glue on a piece of felt or
- 5. Add a tail secure by sewing or gluing.
